Authority figures who help Shawn throughout the text act as exemplars of how to protect at-risk youth. Despite the dark themes, the novel has many moments of beauty and hope. The narrative moves effortlessly from romance to action scenes, and the believable dialogue and heartbreakingly relatable characters will stay with readers long after they have finished reading. Miller delicately handles the difficult topics of abuse, trauma, and grief in a story that is, at its core, about the healing power of compassion and love."
