

### ***Guided Questions for Student Readers***

1. What is the main theme or message of the book as you see it?
2. Are there any characters in the book that you can relate to?
3. Choose a character from the book and describe their personality and motivations. How do they change throughout the story?
4. How do the characters in the book deal with difficult situations and challenges? What can we learn from their experiences?
5. The book addresses issues of resilience and survival. Discuss instances where characters demonstrate resilience.
6. In what ways does the book highlight the importance of empathy and understanding the experience of others, especially those who have faced extreme challenges?
7. What steps can you and your peers take to promote safety and awareness in your school and community?
8. Share a scene or passage from the book that you found particularly impactful. What message do you think the author intended to convey through it?
9. If you could ask the author one question about the book, what would it be?
10. Would you recommend this book to a friend or classmate? Why or why not?
